The purpose of the Youth Council is to promote within the Youth Fellowships of our denomination a combined effort in the cause of Christ. We seek at every opportunity to present to our young people the claims of the Lord Jesus Christ for their lives.

Seeking the salvation of those who are lost in sin that they might come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour.

Each year we organise many events, which have been times of blessing as God has met with us.

A Youth Training week-end for the sole purpose of training young men and women in the area of Personal Evangelism. A course which covers witnessing, testifying, communication skills, open-air evangelism preparing young people to be soul winners.

An Outreach program each summer when a number of our youth visit the smaller churches in our denomination often on the mainland, taking part in door to door visitation and conducting open-air witnessing.

Our young people also organize various open-air meetings across Northern Ireland during the summer months with the distribution of Gospel literature and the proclamation of the gospel message.
